Information on Keio's CEMS Programme

(as of December 2010)

Starting in the academic year 2011, Keio will be a full member of <u>CEMS</u>.

This means that students can apply to the graduate school of economics or graduate school of media design (KMD) to become a CEMS student.

By becoming a CEMS student, a student will be able to study at 2 top management schools around the world, for 6 months each, without paying additional tuition.

If the student successfully finishes Keio's CEMS programme, he/she will receive a Master in International Management (MIM) degree, in addition to the degree conferred from the graduate school of economics or KMD.
