Minimum language proficiency (UG)	Although we do not require any official test record of English like TOEFL or IELTS, we expect the students to be proficient in English both in writing and in communicating in the classroom in order to be able to fulfill the course assignments. We expect that the home institution verifies students' proficiency prior to nominating them to Aalto. The level we expect student to have is equivalent to <u>IELTS 6.5 (total)</u> or <u>TOEFL 92 (total)</u> .
