University profile	Goethe University, founded in 1914, stands out historically among German universities since it was initially established and funded by citizens. In its early years, Goethe University benefited from a culture of private patronage in Frankfurt, a former 'free city' and a centre of trade. As a comparatively young establishment Goethe University has alwas taken a modern approach. It was here, for the first time, that independent faculties for economics, social sciences and the natural science were set up, researching into socially relevant issues. The University soon developed an avant-garde reputation. Prominent academics - Adorno and Horkheimer for instance - taught the 'Frankfurt School' of critical theory, and Laue and Stern lectured in quantum physics. Besides our new main campus in Westend, Goethe University has campuses located in other parts of Frankfurt. All campuses are within easy reach of the amenities of downtown Frankfurt—such as museums, art galleries, theatres, opera and concerts, shopping, restaurants, and sports. International students, researchers and faculty feel at home in Frankfurt—a truly international city where almost one-third of inhabitants are from other countries.
