

Five Year BA/MA Program with Stevens Institute of Technology Application Guidelines for AY2026 (4th year) for PEARL students

- 1. Eligibility: Fourth-year students enrolled in the Faculty of Economics in AY2025
- 2. Maximum number of participants: 5 (total of 1st and 2nd rounds and for PEARL and Type A/B students)
- 3. Application period: October 28 (Tue), 2025 November 4 (Tue), 2025, 16:00 (Japan time)
- 4. Application documents:


- 5. Notes for preparing the required documents and your application:
 - (I) Fill out the prescribed forms.
 - (2) For the Letter of Intent (Form 3), you should write about the reasons why you are applying to this program, what you expect from this program, what you hope to achieve through this program, and anything else you consider appropriate.
 - (3) Please carefully review all the materials before submitting your application because we do not contact applicants even if documents are incomplete.

Convert all documents to PDF and submit via the Google Form above.

- 7. Screening and announcement of the results:
 - (1) Screening by Keio University (Document screening and interview)
 - ①Document screening (the first screening)
 - ②Interview: Thursday, November 27, 2025

Applicants who have passed the first screening will be notified of the details of the interview, including its time and venue, at least one week prior to the interview day.

- ③Announcement of Keio selection results: Early December
- (2) Final Screening (Applying to Stevens and document screening by Stevens)
 - ①Applying to Stevens: After early December (tentative)



②Announcement of final results: After February (tentative)

- Screening is based on a comprehensive assessment. In addition to academic record and English ability, the evaluation criteria also include aspects such as motivation, research ability and preparation for studying abroad.
- * Invitation to the interview and notification of the results will be done via K-Support message.
- * In principle, no withdrawals will be accepted after acceptance.

8. Notes on course registration

You are required to earn a minimum of 8 credits for four Keio courses with a grade of "B" or above transferrable to Stevens. You may not count these credits toward Keio's graduation requirements of I 26 credits, so carefully plan your course work. Please register for any courses intended for credit transfer as optional courses.
